Universal Recycling: Collier County, Florida, USA

Summary

Collier County expanded its successful mandatory business recycling program to include multi-family properties in 2009. Property owners are required to provide recycling services and education to residents.

Overview of Recycling Requirements

Multi-family properties with three or more units are required to provide recycling containers to and printed educational materials to residents at least twice per year. Properties should have prominent signage for the location of recycling containers.

Multi-family properties are required to contract for recycling services with the county's franchised collector of residential recycling.

Background

Collier County adopted a mandatory business recycling ordinance in 2004. The ordinance was revised in 2009 to include multi-family properties and events.
